WHY DO WE NEED A NEW INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL COURT?

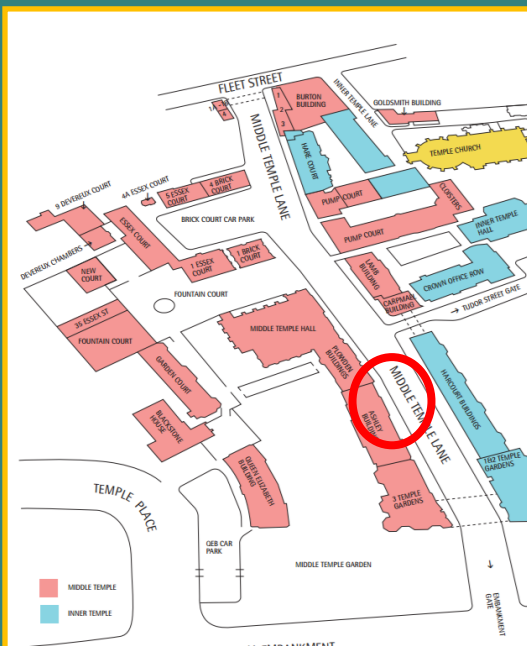
